Minutes of June 20, 2012 Meeting

The meeting was called to order at 7:00pm by President Bruno.

Craig reported that the barn restoration will begin in the next week or two. Before then, we will have to remove the chicken coop. The cost of renting a dumpster and then enlisting volunteers to do the work was discussed. It was finally agreed to let the contractor, Eliot Lothrop of Building Heritage LLC, do the work as an add-on to the contract. Dig Safe needs to be contacted to mark any underground utilities in the area before work is begun.

The Fourth of July Parade was then discussed. Craig unveiled his poster announcing the barn project and asking for donations and volunteers. He will develop banners (3) for the donation station and both sides of the hearse. Leon said he would take care of having the posters made once Craig finalized the design. The hearse will have to be put in temporary storage before the parade and the runners need to be taken to Ken Blair's barn. Wayne volunteered to take care of the moving. John Goss will take care of getting chairs and tables from the firehouse for our donation stations, one at the sign near Rebecca's and one at the gazebo. Jack will supply the jars for donations. Members interested in helping out on the Fourth should report to Rebecca's front porch at 8:30am for their assignments.

The pictures referred to in last month's minutes need to be picked-up at Parade Gallery. Cindi said another picture needs to be fixed and that the two pictures on the first floor of the library need to be rehung. They are currently in the storage room.

Our next meeting will be July 18.
