

Phase I includes relocation of the barn to meet requirements of the Warren Town Plan, installation of a new foundation & slab on grade as well as structural repair and installation of electrical service in preparation for future exhibits. Work has commenced on this phase as of June 27, 2012.

Phase II includes repair and restoration of the barn's walls, windows, doors, and roof in order to provide a weather tight structure for future exhibits. The Society hopes to complete this work through a combination of volunteer and professional labor.

Phase III includes installation of permanent exhibits related to the history of Warren as well as a permanent display dedicated to the historic Warren hearse. The Society is looking for both monetary donations as well as historic artifacts to tell the story of Warren.
