

**Further Information Pertinent to the Town of Warren  
Request for Qualifications from Design Engineers  
Re Covered Bridge #6 Restoration**

In response to questions from engineering firms participating in Warren's request for qualifications, we are posting this additional information:

1. The closing date has been moved back to January 10, 2013, at 3:00PM. Correspondingly, all other dates regarding the Town's response to proposals have been moved back one week as well.
2. "Attachment A" referred to in the Request has been posted on the Town's website as well. The site may be accessed at [www.warrenvt.org](http://www.warrenvt.org), and the Request can be found under the Public Works section at the left of the home page.
3. The 1995 McFarland Johnson study of The Warren Covered Bridge has been posted on the website as well, as has a 2009 Hydraulics Unit study of the bridge site.
4. The engineering and permitting portion of this project is likely to take Place in 2013, with construction projected in 2014, at low water flow.
5. The Town will have at it's disposal a Transportation Enhancement Grant of \$300,000, with the Town's share an additional \$75,000. This figure will include engineering costs, including some onsite supervision.
6. As a consequence of studies done on the status of the timber crib dam downstream of the covered bridge, test borings to refusal have been done in the vicinity of the bridge that will be made available when the design proceeds.
7. As stated in the Request for Qualifications, site visits may be arranged with Barry Simpson, LPM for this project and Warren Public Works Director.
