



Two types of fire hydrants exist on Sugarbush properties.

The first are owned and managed by the Mountain Water Company (MWC), and are fed by Sugarbush's domestic water system.

The second are part of Sugarbush's Snowmaking Dept., and are fed by the Mad River Pond on Rte. 100. (See reverse for details)

With the single exception of the hydrant at the intersection of the Sugarbush Access Road and Village Road, all hydrants on this map are of the former type, fed by MWC pipes.






Sugarbush's
