The Warren Development Review Board has scheduled public hearings at 7:00 PM, Monday, September 17th, 2012 at the Warren Municipal Building to consider the following matter.

Application 2012-33-CU, Conditional Use Review, Reconfiguration of a non-conforming existing Parking Lot and Setback relief for a deck adjacent to German Flats Road. The Zoning Administrator has referred the application of 3209 German Flats Road LLC(dba Common Man) to the Development Review Board.

The property is located in the Vacation Residential District at 3209 German Flats Road (parcel id # 006002-100.) This application requires review under Article 3, § 3.6 (C1)(Height & Setback Requirements), § 3.8(Non Complying Structure & Non-Conforming Uses), § 3.10(Parking, Loading & Service Area Requirements) and Article 5, § 5.3 of the Warren Land Use and Development Regulations as adopted by the Warren Select Board on August 24th, 2011.

A proposed re-delineation of the existing interim 3000' circle Source Protection Area for the Farms at Club Sugarbush Well 1, was developed by the Weston & Sampson. Delineation of a public community water supply Source Protection Area requires approval under 10 VSA, Section 1679 (Legislative requirement to give notice to the public for a proposed Source Protection Area). Well 1 (WL001) is located behind the Farms at Club Sugarbush Condominiums in Warren, Vermont.

A map showing the location of the proposed Source Protection Area may be found in the Warren Town Clerk's Office.
