

Application: 2013-01-SD/Amendment to an approved plat and clarification of language regarding cutting restrictions for the Sardi Fourth lot subdivision dated October 18, 2006 (2006-09-SD) plat filed on June 20, 2007. The applicant, June Sardi, requests a revision in the location of the building envelope and modification of the "findings" as follows: No 4 not to require enrollment in the Current Use Program; and to add to No 8 to allow periodic timbering in accordance with a forest management plan. This application requires review under Section 6.7 Revisions to an Approved Plat property located at 59 Main Street, parcel id #004000-200. The property is located at 2255 west Hill Road in the Rural Residential and Forest Reserve Districts (Parcel Dina 016004-600). This application requires review under Article 2, table 2.2 & 2.1; and Article 7, of the Warren Land Use and Development Regulations as adopted by the Warren Select Board on March 25, 2008 and last amended November 11, 2012.
