


The Warren Development Review Board has scheduled a public hearing at 7:00 PM, Monday, August 31st, 2015 at the Warren Municipal Building to consider the following Application.

Application 2015-39-SD/CU, (Rescheduled for August 3, 2015) Final Plan Review for a two lot Minor Subdivision: Long Associates request Final Plan Review for the subdivision of their existing 23.4 acre parcel into two lots: The two new lots will be subdivide as: Lot A, 9. +/- acres and Lot B, 14 +/- acres). The two parcels contain slopes exceeding 15%, and require conditional use review. The access to the property is off of Morning Star Drive and is located in the Rural Residential District, Parcel Identification Number 005001-411.
