WARNING OF TOWN MEETING


The legal voters of the Town of Fayston are hereby notified and warned to meet at the Fayston Elementary School on Tuesday, March 1, 2016 at 9:30 A.M. to transact the following business:

- Article 1. To elect a Moderator for the year ensuing. David Jones' term expires.
- Article 2. To elect a Town Clerk for the year ensuing. Patti Lewis' term expires.
- Article 3. To hear and act upon the reports of the Town Officers for the year 2015.
- Article 4. To see if the Town will authorize the Selectboard to borrow money in anticipation of general revenue and with short term notes fund the Capital Budget.
- Article 5. Shall the Town pay the Board of Selectmen's expenses, and if so, how much?
- Article 6. To assess a time of payment of education and municipal taxes. Property taxes are due 30 days from generation of the bills. Taxes not paid by November 1, 2016 (postmarks (not metered mail) accepted), a one-time penalty of 8% and interest of 1% for the first three months and 1.5% thereafter shall be applied.
- Article 7. To elect a Treasurer for the year ensuing. Patti Lewis' term expires.

- Article 19. To transact any other business which may properly come before the meeting?





The Warren Development Review Board has scheduled a public hearing at 7:00 PM, Monday, February 15th, 2016 at the Warren Municipal Building to consider the following application.

Application 2016-05-SD, Subdivision Amendment to the "Berggren" subdivision issued by the Planning Commission on November 11th, 1989. The applicant, Scott Kingsbury, request an amendment to the previously filed plat to relocate the permitted house site and building envelope. The Waitsfield Cemetery Commission is seeking bids for the position of Cemetery Sexton. This position is responsible for the upkeep of the following four cemeteries located in Waitsfield Vermont;

- Common Cemetery
- Wait Cemetery
- Village Hill Cemetery
- Irasville Cemetery

\* Cemeteries shall be opened from May 1st to November 1st annually although contractor obligations per this agreement begin April 15 and end November 15. Duties include but are not limited to:

- Spring and fall cleanup of leaves, branches, and debris from each property.
- Leveling and seeding of all mounds and depressions.
- Repairs of any damaged fencing.
- Mowing and trimming of all cemeteries. Special attention paid to Mother's Day, Memorial Day, Father's Day, and Independence Day. At times, the contractor will be required to mow specific sections in advance of funerals.
- Opening and closing of graves as well as being present for burials.
- Filling, leveling, and seeding as needed of all graves.

The contract will be awarded for three years with the option to renew for another three years. The contract will be awarded to the lowest average price for the three-year term, and/or to the most responsible bidder. All bidders must own and operate their own equipment and have valid liability and workman's compensation insurance, and include valid documentation in this bid package.

Bid packages must be received by February 12, 2016 to be considered.

The Cemetery Commission of Waitsfield reserves the right to accept or reject any and all bids, and to take that action deemed most advantageous to the Commission.
