

Announcement

The Town of Warren has just received word that it has been awarded majority funding to implement the Warren Village Main Street Improvement Project. The project consists of final design plans, engineering, and construction of sidewalk and streetscape improvements on Main Street between Brook Rd. the Freeman Brook Bridge.

The purpose of the project is the enhancement of streetscaping and traffic calming measures within this area, such as visually “narrowing” Main Street using paving surfaces, installation of movable planters, enhanced parallel parking, implementation of sidewalk enhancements, installation of crosswalks & wayfinding signage.

The 90% project funding comes from the State of Vermont’s Community Development Block Grant-Disaster Recovery II Grant. The project’s conceptual design was developed through Warren’s 2013 Vermont Downtown Action Team (V-DAT) planning process - built upon previous sidewalk and traffic calming studies (1996 Warren Village Improvements Plan, 2004 Warren Village Pedestrian Enhancement Plan, Sidewalk Feasibility Study, 2009 Warren School Travel Plan, & 2013 Warren Safe Routes to School Study).
