

# Mad Bus rides again

The Mad River Valley's seasonal bus service, the Mad Bus, will begin running again on December 4.

The Valley Floor route is operational between December 4 and March 20 with late season weekend service on March 26 and 27 and April 2 and 3. Saturday evening service runs most Saturdays from December 11 through March 26 (plus select holidays).

The Saturday evening service is a demand-response route that operates between 6 p.m. and 2 a.m. The bus leaves Lincoln Peak every hour on the hour and covers the Access Road between Lincoln Peak and Route 100, Route 100 between Warren village and Waitsfield village, Route 17 between Route 100 and the Battleground as well as German Flats Road.

The Warren shuttle has daily service beginning December 4 through Sunday, March 20. In addition to scheduled stops between Warren and Sugarbush, stops and pickups may be requested.

The Mount Ellen route that connects Sugarbush North with Lincoln Peak begins daily service on December 17 until March 27. The Harwood Freerider bus that brings students from Harwood to Mount Ellen starts running on Mondays and Thursdays from December 13 until March 17.

The Mountain Condo route starts running on December 4 and finishes on March 30 with some late season weekend service. The route serves the Sugarbush condominiums; Dial-a-ride is available at the resorts from 11:45 a.m. until 5:50 p.m.

The Sugarbush Access Road route also runs from December 4 through March 20; the route covers the Sugarbush Access Road to Lincoln Peak between 11:45 a.m. and 5:50 p.m. The SnowCap Commuter charges passengers a fare to travel between towns and to the various ski areas; the Mad River Glen stop is by request only.

The Mad Bus is funded by a mix of local funds required to match federal and state funding. This year, GMTA representatives Tawnya Kristen and Meredith Birkett were present at the annual tri-town select board summit to make

formal requests for funding from each of The Valley towns.

Warren's allocation is \$943, Waitsfield's is \$923 and Fayston's is \$588. With the local funds they receive, GMTA is able to secure 80 percent matching federal funding.


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## TOWN OF WARREN

The Warren Zoning Administrator is considering the following applications for Administrative Review, as per Article 9, Section 9.8 (F) Administrative Review.

Application 2010-10-SD-AR Boundary Line Adjustment: An application has been submitted by The Judy B Proux Rev Trust, Judy B Proux Trustee, requesting a Boundary line Adjustment of 2.5 ± acres between their 10.2 ± acre lot off Ridge View Rd (Parcel Id, 002003-800) and the adjacent 8.5 ± Acre Parcel at 800 Ridge View Rd (Parcel Id 002004-300) owned by Ridge View Holdings, LTD. The purpose of this request is to move the easterly boundary of the property to coincide with the westerly boundary of the existing right-of-way. The boundary line adjustment will increase the acreage the 8.5 ± acre parcel and decrease the acreage of the 10.2 acre parcel by 2.5± acres. The subject lots are in the Rural Residential District (minimum lot size 1 acre); were created prior to subdivision regulations; and no new development is requested with this application.

Pursuant to Article 9, Section 9.8 (F) Administrative Review (1) (d). The standards require notice to the abutting land owners as well as the members of the DRB, and if any interested person, including a DRB member, feels this application should be reviewed by the DRB instead of the Administrative Officer then they may file such a request with either the Secretary of the Development Review Board or the Town Clerk within fifteen (15) days of the date of this published notice, Thursday, December 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2010.
