BOUNDARY LINE ADJUSTMENT

#2012-01-SD.AR.Bla: Jill R. Bobrow to Travis L. Morse. .20 ± acres

The applicants, Travis L. Morse and Jill R. Bobrow, request a boundary line adjustment of 0.2 of an acre. The revised Boundary Line Adjustment of 0.20± acres will increase the 42.77 ± acre lot at 4690 VT RTE 100 (Parcel Id, 100006-200) to 42.97 and decrease the adjacent 24.90± acre parcel of Jill R. Bobrow. (Parcel Id 100006-900) to 24.70 ± acres.

The purpose of this request is to move a portion of the south-westerly boundary of the property approximately 50' to 100' to add .20 ± acres to the Morse property.

The subject parcels are in the Rural Residential District (minimum lot size 1 acre); and were created prior to subdivision regulations; and no new development is requested with this application.

This approval meets requirements found under Sec. 9.8 Municipal Administrative Requirements, (F) Administrative Review (1) (d). As such, all abutting land owners were given written notice with proof of mailing on June 7th, 2012. On the same date, notice was published in the Valley Reporter and posted in three public places in the municipality, including posting of the notice within view of the public right(s)-of-way nearest to the subject property.

The Administrative Officer (AO) found the following:

- The applicant submitted a proposed Boundary Line Adjustment Plan prepared by Glenn R. Towne.
- The reconfigured lots conform to the standards of the Rural Residential District (Article 2, Table 2.2 of the WLU&DR) and no new lots will be created by this action.
- The boundary line adjustment will not create any non-conforming lots.
- There is no development proposed for this property or related to this transaction

Notice of Decision:

Based on the above findings, the AO hereby approves based on the above findings, the application for a boundary line adjustment of 0.20 acres is approved.

In accordance with Sec. 9.8 Municipal Administrative Requirements, (F) Administrative Review (1) (d) of the Warren Land Use and Development Regulations, the Administrative Officer hereby approves, based on the above findings, the application for the boundary line adjustment as proposed in application #2012-01-SD.AR.Bla subject to the requirement that a revised deed be filed with the Warren Town Clerk prior to or at the same time as the filing of the mylar.
